

GHERARDO UGOLINI

Gherardo Ugolini was born in Brescia, Italy, on 28 June 1960. Secondary school diploma at the Liceo-Ginnasio «Arnaldo» in Brescia (1979). He conducted his own studies at the Faculty of Letters and Humanities of the University of Pavia (1979-1984), where he was follower of the University-College Ghislieri. He graduated in Greek Literatur (supervisor: Prof. Diego Lanza).

After graduation he continued his studies and his research in Germany thanks to a scholarship of the Foundation «Maximilianeum» in Munich (1984/85). He acquired a PhD. in Classical Philology at the Ludwig-Maximilian-University in Munich (supervisor: Prof. Hellmut Flashar), and got a second PhD. in Historical Sciences at the Scuola Superiore di Studi Storici of the Republic of San Marino (supervisor: Prof. Luciano Canfora).

In the year 1990 he spent a period of study in Berlin, as guest of the German Academy of Sciences in the ambit of the exchange-program between the Italian National Research Council (CNR) and foreign institutions. From 1993 to 1999 he was lecturer at the Ruprecht-Karl-University in Heidelberg. From 1999 to 2008 he was lecturer at the Humboldt-University in Berlin. From 2008 to 2012 he has been teaching Classical Philology at the University Verona (Incentive Program for the comeback of Italian scholars abroad). His research interests are particularly in the following fields: the ancient Greek tragedy, the young Nietzsche as philologist, the tradition of classic culture in the modern literary tradition.
