

HOW CAN I SIGN UP FOR COURSES?

- There is no need to sign up for courses
- The Modules "to be chosen" must be selected in the "piano di studi" in order to take the exam. To do this, you have to use the ESSE3 system (which we will explain in a moment)

WHICH MODULES SHOULD I TAKE? WHICH ONES ARE COMPULSORY?

• If you don't know whether to attend a module or not, first check if it is compulsory or elective at the link below (start with those of the first year):

IS IT MANDATORY TO BE PRESENT IN CLASS?

- In general, attendance is not compulsory
- For some modules attendance is strongly advised

WHAT COURSES CAN I TAKE TO GET THE CFU NEEDED FOR "FURTHER LANGUAGE SKILLS"?

- You can take Italian as L2, German, Spanish, French and English at the Center for Foreign Languages (CLA)
- Credits can be obtained starting from the B1 level (I.E. 3 CFU for a B1 and further 3 CFU for the B2)





WHAT ABOUT THE CREDITS DEDICATED TO "ACTIVITIES TO BE CHOSEN BY THE STUDENTS"?

- 12 credits of type D can be gained attending various modules/activities
- These may be chosen among courses of other Departments available in the "piano di studi" (study plan) section in ESSE3.
- Otherwise, up to 6 of these D credits may be obtained through:
- 1) Competence in further language skills (higher than B1)
- 2) Certification of a training activity carried out both inside and outside the Department (i.e. TOEFL Exam, Teacher trainings, or other courses). These training activities must be pre-approved by the Collegio Didattico

WHEN AND HOW SHOULD I APPLY FOR THE EXAMS? IS THERE A DEADLINE FOR THE EXAM REGISTRATION?

- You have to apply after completion of the course
- Before you can sign up you must complete a questionnaire about the course
- Questionnaire and registration for the exams can be done using ESSE3
- The deadline for registration is indicated for each exam. You are also allowed to cancel your registration

ARE BOOKS AND EXAMS ALL IN ENGLISH?

- Bibliographic references and exams are in English for the compulsory courses
- In this degree program there are also modules on other languages: Italian, German, French, Spanish, Russian. For these modules, materials and exams could be in the respective languages...
- but: German and Russian Linguistics are taught in English.
- Also the Philology exams are taught in English (with the exception of Romance philology which may be taught in French).

WHAT IS AN "APPELLO"?

- It's the exam itself. It can be oral or written or both
- The sessions of exams are 3 per academic year (Winter Session → January and February, Summer Session → June and July, Autumn Session → September)
- Each session has 2 'appelli' for each course (two opportunities to take the exam)
- Therefore, you have 6 overall chances per year to pass the exam of a course

HOW CAN I FIND OUT THE RESULTS OF MY EXAMS?

- Total Points (written/oral): 30
- Minimum to pass: 18
- For oral exams: grade communicated to the student
- For written exams:
 - e-learning (Moodle) platform
 - e-mail
- If you are not satisfied with your grade you have to inform the professor about it after the results are published and you may re take the exam


- WHAT IS ESSE3?

From the <u>home page of university</u>, scroll down to see the Aree Riservate and choose ESSE3 or MYUNIVR, by clicking on any of these,




You will be seeing a page like this.

Here you need to enter your username and password given to you after your enrollment has been completed.



STUDY PLAN (PIANO DI STUDIO) OF FIRST YEAR STUDENTS



- All the students enrolled in the first year will see a Study Plan being automatically set for them.
- This plan contains only compulsory courses, so it will not include activities to be chosen by students or activities to be chosen among a group of courses.
- Please note: Students enrolled in a master's degree "under condition" will complete the plan only after achievement of a three-year degree.

From late September to mid June 2020


SO IS IT COMPULSORY TO COMPLETE THE PLAN?

- To be able to access E-learning, in case the teacher has chosen this access policy via MyUnivr




BOOKING EXAMS:
